Dear Richard:

Our hospital in Henrietta, Texas which is a level IV trauma center moved their helicopter landing zone a block away to a church parking lot. Air-Evac Life team stationed a medical helicopter in Wichita Falls, Texas 15 miles away. Before this the nearest helicopter was in Ft. Worth 150 miles away, therefore it was not used much.

Our new site was surrounded on three sides with power lines and with no marking on any lines. As an EMT-1 with the hospital, a firefighter with the local Fire Dept, and a member of the city council I started to try and get markers for the lines. After numerous hours of searching the web, I came across your site and found the AV-WS-1000 spinning markers. When I called and talked to you and you gave me the price of them I was not expecting much. You sent me a demo to look at and boy was I surprised. They were highly reflective and compact enough to not add undue weight on the lines. I ordered 5 more and finally had the local electric company install them. Within a week we had to use the landing site and the helicopter pilot told me that he wished all sights were as well marked as ours was. The pilot said the LZ could be seen over a mile away!!!

Richard, just let me say that I am glad we purchased the spinning markers and I would highly recommend them to anyone needing a landing zone. If your customers needs a recommendation, please have them contact me.
